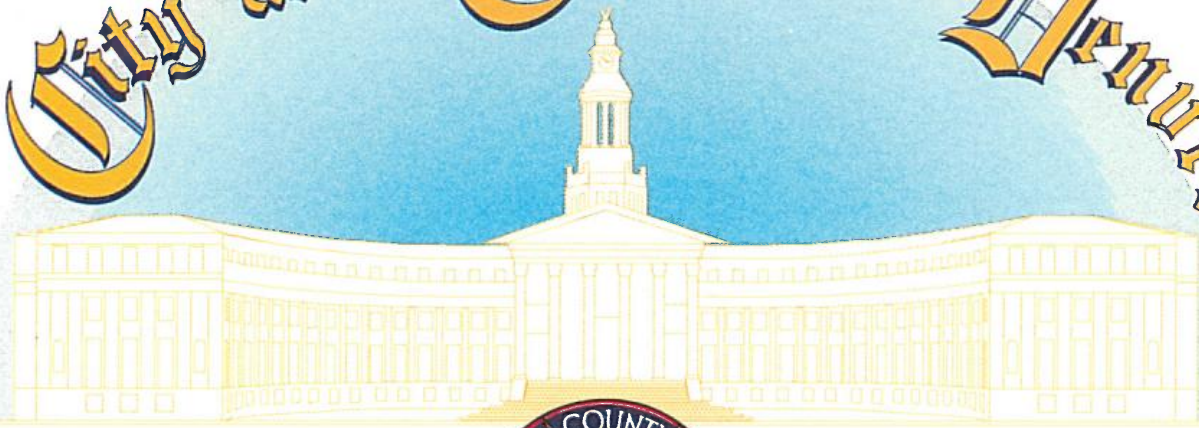


# City and County of Denver



## Proclamation

**WHEREAS,** *implementing clean energy policies and programs will help boost economic opportunities and job creation while continuing to move toward a sustainable future; and*

**WHEREAS,** *with more than 2.2 million Americans working in the energy efficiency sector, cutting energy waste saves consumers in the United States billions of dollars on their utility bills annually, including up to \$500 per household from appliance efficiency standards; and*

**WHEREAS,** *smarter energy use reduces the amount of electricity we need to power our lives, which helps avoid power plant emissions that can harm our health, pollute our air and change our climate; and*

**WHEREAS,** *Denver residents can continue to contribute to our energy efficiency efforts by learning about participating in local government and utility energy programs.*

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, MICHAEL B. HANCOCK, MAYOR** of the City and County of Denver, Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby officially proclaim **OCTOBER 5, 2017**, to be known as:
