Be it known that

Whereas,

Smarter energy use saved consumers and businesses money and helps avoid power plant emissions that can harm our health, pollute our air, and warm our climate; and

Whereas,

The City of Austin through its public utility provides approximately \$20 million in incentives for energy efficiency every year, with a goal of reducing energy use by at least one percent; and

Whereas,

The City of Austin has adopted energy codes to make new construction more energy-efficient and developed a unique Green Building Program that encourages and recognizes architects and developers that meet more aggressive green building features; and

Whereas,

The City of Austin has set a community-wide goal of getting to zero carbon emissions by 2050, and energy efficiency efforts will be an important part of this effort;
